## Norwegian Ecovillages autumn 2014



### Norwegian Ecovillage Association

This list is put together by the Norwegian Ecovillage Association (Norsk Okosamfunns Forening, NOF). It was first put together in 2013, and is updated in the autumn of 2014. It will be used to update a similar list in a year from now.

The Norwegian Ecovillage Network has over 300 members on the electronic mailing list and another 300 on Facebook. The network sends out between 4 and 6 electronic newsletters annually and arranges several open meetings in the Oslo area every spring and autumn. These are attended by between 10 and 30 participants, and various Ecovillage projects are presented. In October 2014, a seminar on Ecovillage Living was held by Craig Gibsone from Findhorn and Jan Martin Bang. Similar seminars are planned for 2015.

The list is divided up into three areas. The first is a list of **Established Ecovillages**, the second a list of **Forming Ecovillages** (that are in the process of being formed), the third list a number of other **Partner Organisations** that we work closely with, supporting each other in creating a sustainable future. We include them because we see them as essential co-workers, but not necessarily resident Ecovillages.

The list contains 8 established Ecovillages, 17 in formation and 5 partner organisations. This is a significant a significant rise in activity during the last year. The listings are in alphabetical order.

### Established Ecovillages

#### Alvdal Eco Village (Gaiagrenda Alvdal)

**Description:** Farm from 1919 with upgraded outbuildings and a residential building including 1000 square metres of commercial premises for conferences, meeting facilities and accommodation for 30 guests today. There are plans for taking over a small travel agency (Total Helse) in 2014 and to arrange seminars in green living and back to nature concept. There are also plans for buying property nearby and building 50 round houses to accommodate families, members and guests, starting in 2015. Plans for growing our own food and bring our work with us to build up a sustainable community in Alvdal to be self sufficient during 2016.

**History and status:** The farm was bought December 2012. Three small wooden cabins were bought and a restaurant with all the inventory, furniture, kitchen equipment etc. before Christmas and quickly increased our capacity for accommodation to a higher level.

3000 hours of volunteer work was done during 2013.

In 2014 Gaia Homes was established and signed a contract as an authorized distributor of Mandala Homes in Europe.

The work with the zoning for Gaiagrenda Eco Village started early 2014 and the final application will be delivered to the municipality of Alvdal in November. Final approval of the zoning is expected in June 2015.

In the summer of 2015 the first round Mandala Homes will be built in Norway. We have plans for building 4 Mandala houses in 2015, and a increasing number in the following years.

**Size:** 15 persons are now shareowners in Gaia Holding, which is the mother company. We invite new shareholders 2 times a year, and there will be 10 more in 2015.

Many helpful hands from friends and families are actively engaged in the project at present. 2 persons are staying as residents on the farm on a permanent basis and 2-3 more will move to Alvdal in 2015, and the number of permanent residents will increase as fast as we can build our round houses in Gaiagrenda.

**Hurdal Ecovillage (Hurdalsjoeen Oekologiske Landsby SA)**

**Description:** Today the property has gained legal consent to build 150 living units; building commenced in summer 2013 and should be completed within 5 years. In 2014 the ecovillage takes title of a neighbouring school which will be converted to a sustainable business-centre with café, bakery, classes in various arts and topics and a centre for sustainable research.

**History:** Hurdal Ecovillage was started in 2002 by a small group of people who formed a cooperative and bought an old farm with 173 acres of land in Hurdal.

**Size:** Around 20 people is currently living in the village. There is also 40 acres of farmland on which grow vegetables and hay for the animals.

**Location:** 55 minutes north of Oslo.

## **Nesjar Ecovillage**

**Description:** Nesjar Ecovillage is situated on Nesja Farm, a regulated housing area, surrounded by beautiful nature, with a view over the Slidre Fjord and the Jotunheim Mountains. The farm is being turned to organic practice. The future residents will have their own allotments for gardening and will have an opportunity to participate in the growing and preparation of berries, vegetables and meat, in addition they will have access to firewood forests and mountains. The farm will have horses, sheep and cows. The farm is close to school, kindergarden, shops, public transport, mountains, forests and lakes.

**History:** Nesja Farm is an old farm with several old, large houses, in a traditional farming area, where the surroundings allow for the growing of good, clean food. Here it will be possible to follow "barefoot living".

**Size:** Regulated building area is 140 hectares, with an additional workshop area of 90 hectares. The farm has 1300 hectares cultivated land, about 400 hectares grazing and 8000 hectares forest. In addition there is a small mountain farm and extensive mountain grazing rights.

**Location:** Nesja farm is in the middle of Southern Norway, 200 klms. north of Oslo, 300 klms. south of Trondheim, and 300 klms. east of Bergen.

## Sofieville

**Description:** Sofieville is an international, spiritual ecovillage initiative in Norway, politically and religiously independent. The vision is a place where people can develop their higher awareness in community with others, a place where people, animals and plants live in a dynamic and harmonic cooperation with each other, with nature and the universe. We wish for an ecovillage that is sustainable, where we will build up self sufficiency and recycling. In this way we will create one model for future lifestyles.

We will also build a part of Sofieville as an Ecological Health Farm, where traditional medicine and alternative nature medicine work together hand in hand, and where we take back respect for people from birth to death. Because everyone is part of their own healing process, we would like to create new ways, where those who are "sick" or challenged, can participate in a larger scale than is usual today. For this we will need a range of different professions.

**History:** The project started in February 2012, after two visits to Auroville in India. Today we are a core group of 10 with another 10 who are evaluating their membership. We have had 7 weekend meetings and 3 study trips in Norway. We have bought the domains [www.sofieville.org](http://www.sofieville.org) and [www.sofieville.com](http://www.sofieville.com). Our plan is to find a site and begin establishment in 2015.
